



## MEDICAL RELEASE, AUTHORIZATION TO OBTAIN TREATMENT, LIABILITY WAIVER AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

This is to certify that I, as the parent or guardian of the above listed player, hereby grant permission to the adult manager, coach, or other league official to obtain medical care, at my expense, from any licensed physician, hospital or medical clinic, for the player named herein at such time as either parent or legal guardian cannot be contacted. This authorization shall include all league activities, including the period required to travel to and from those activities. We do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless, Kirkland Pony Baseball (KBC), the organizers, supervisors, participants and persons transporting the player to and from those activities, for any and all claims arising out of an injury to the player.

I understand and agree that the player assumes all risk of injury associated with the participation in youth athletic competition and its related activities. I acknowledge, understand and agree that neither Kirkland Pony Baseball (KBC) nor its officers, agents, employees, players or volunteer workers are liable in any way for any occurrence in connection with league activities that may result in injury, death or other damages to the player, me or my family, estate, heirs or assigns. It is the intention of the undersigned to exempt and release Kirkland Pony Baseball (KBC), the organizers, supervisors, participants and persons transporting the player to and from these activities from any and all liability from personal injury, property damage or death caused by negligence or other fault of any person hereby held harmless.

### PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT

By registering by child with payment, I agree and approve my child's enrollment in Kirkland Baseball Commission Pony program as well as the following policies. I will take responsibility for ensuring that he/she complies with our player participation policy and I agree that any violations of these regulations will subject the player to dismissal from the program with no refund.

I also take responsibility for ensuring that the player arrives on the playing field no more than 1 hour prior to the start of the game/practice and is picked up promptly at the end of the game/practice.

### FILM AND PHOTOGRAPHY RELEASE

Occasionally, Pony Baseball will take photographs and/or videotapes during games, practices and events. Photos and videos are used for many different purposes including newspaper articles, publications, promotional materials and a yearbook. We need your signature on file to give your permission to use photos/videos of your child for these purposes.

I consent to and authorize Pony Baseball to take photographs in film or print form of my child to be used for the purpose of promoting Pony Baseball without compensation to me. If you do not sign, than no photo(s) or video(s) of your son or daughter will appear in the yearbook or any other publications. All film and enlargements are the sole property of the Kirkland Baseball Commission.

## PLAYER PARTICIPATION POLICY

**THIS FORM MUST BE SIGNED AND SUBMITTED TO THE LEAGUE  
BEFORE A PLAYER CAN BE ASSIGNED TO A TEAM.**

Participation in Kirkland Baseball Commission (KBC) is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. To be eligible, each athlete must meet the Pony Baseball age requirements and live within the boundaries of the Lake Washington School District.
2. Before an athlete can participate in a game, he/she must attend a minimum number of practices.
3. Attendance at practices, meetings and games is required unless excused by a coach. One unexcused absence during a week may preclude player from starting the next scheduled game. Three unexcused absences may result in suspension from the team.
4. Sound training habits are essential to the welfare of players and are strictly enforced. Once a coach has explained training regulations and guidelines, the player should make every effort to follow them. Use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, or other illegal drugs during the KBC season will result in disciplinary action in accordance with Pony Baseball rules.
5. Athletes are encouraged to demonstrate citizenship, sportsmanship and conduct that is beyond criticism at all times. Players involved in such action as stealing, vandalism, physical fighting or other unacceptable behavior will be suspended or removed from a team.
6. When an injury is sustained during practice or competition, the supervising coach should be notified immediately in order to administer or obtain proper care. If the injury requires further medical attention, an accident report should be obtained and processed as soon as possible.
7. Athletes receiving KBC equipment are responsible for it. If the equipment is lost or damaged, the athlete will be required to pay for a replacement. The athletic equipment used by KBC is purchased for use during practice or competition, and is not worn or used at any other time.
